Gondar Gardens reservoir - planning application submitted, February 2011

Dear all,

Linden Wates have submitted a planning application for the Gondar Gardens reservoir site.

Here are the headlines ...

- LW's proposal is as per their exhibition in October: 16 houses within the area of the disused reservoir coupled with long-term protection for the undeveloped areas.
- Camden will notify 250+ local residents about the planning application, but only once they
 have received an Environmental Impact Assessment from LW. We will then have 21 days to
 respond (GARA will ask for this to be extended).
- LW's documentation is extensive but their basic argument remains unchanged (that their scheme plus funding for affordable housing elsewhere in Camden is sufficient to overcome the Open Space and Site of Nature Conservation Interest policies).
- GARA is seeking professional input on planning, transport, ecology and other parts of the application.
- GARA will hold an EGM on Thursday 3rd March at 7.45pm at the Fortune Green Play Centre.
 We have invited LW to present their proposals, after which they will leave and we will discuss the way forward.
